Health & Safety Guide to running MGAI Competitions

THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY TO ALL COMPETITIONS

- 1) The date of the competition must be approved by the Chairperson of MGA Ireland before the competition can be organised.
- 2) The organiser **MUST** be a member of MGA Ireland and the competition must be run under MGA Ireland rules and regulations.
- 3) A Health & Safety Representative must be appointed and notified to MGAI Health & Safety Officer.
- 4) Adequate First Aid cover must be organised for the competition. Paramedic cover is preferable for larger events.
- 5) A standard Risk Assessment Form should be completed by the Health & Safety Representative for the venue and submitted to the Health & Safety Officer
- 6) Local veterinarian contact details on call should be captured.

A form detailing these requirements is attached to these notes. This form **MUST** be completed and submitted it to the Chairperson/H&S Officer prior to the competition taking place.
